



CASTING ON WITH E-WRAP


Set up the yarn by threading it through the yarn guide.




Tie the yarn to the machine leg, place the carriage on the right hand side.




Move a selection of needles all the way forward.




Guide the yarn upward inbetween the first and second needle.




Guide around needle one, then under and over needle two.




Continue by going under and then over each needle, forming small sideways e's.




Feed the yarn through the carriage (A) and then close.




Knit the first row by moving the carriage.



Hold the stitches backward, using your hands or a needle pusher as pictured, and move all needles forward.



Repeat this several times: hold stitches back, move needles forward and move carriage to knit.



Then, add the cast-on comb and weights.



Now, you can move the carriage freely and knit!
